To the Esteemed Authority, H.E. David Kam, Co-Secretary General of Free Nations

Following the historical importance of the signing of the Two Row Wampum Convention of the Balkans which extends the Two Row Wampum (Treaty) (Teiohate Kuswenta - GaswÈÒdah) first established in the year 1613 ("Convention"), we hereby establish the following:

The _{SN}©lerahkwa ne Kenienke™ (aka Iroquois of Kanienke, Mohawk Nation), exercise its sovereign power for the well-being of its population and the highest ideals of regional leadership hereby commit to protect women and children and securing future generations with an unwavering dedication to peace and progress. We officially proclaim and accept all stipulations outlined in this alliance.

The Parties to the Convention acknowledge and recognize its adherence to the Diplomatic Manifesto of Global Sovereignty as prescribed by the United Nations of the Balkan Federation and the Marine Foundation / DWB Development World Bank.

As part of this alliance, The Parties shall be a signatory to the multilateral Iroquois Convention Trade Agreement with the United Nations of the Balkan Federation.

The Balkan Federation hereby acknowledges and recognizes the Parties to the Convention as sovereign and independent nations.

The Parties agree that the Duck Creek 3 mineral parcel, valued at over 100 billion dollars ("Asset"), will be notarized and utilized as commodities for use in trade enhancement programs, monetization, and for backing the currencies in the Convention, including and not limited to, the Sovereign Akwesasne Central Bank Digital Currency (SACBDC) and the Mason Dollar, which will be adopted by the Parties in their economy. The final assignment for the use of the Asset shall rest with the SN©lerahkwa ne Kenienke™ (aka Iroquois of Kanienke, Mohawk Nation).

All trade and business transactions will be managed by the _{SN}©lerahkwa ne Kenienke™ (aka Iroquois of Kanienke, Mohawk Nation), represented by Honorable _{SN}©Takoda Ahanu™, Minister of Finance and the depository will be in the Sovereign Akwesasne Central Bank (SACB).

The Parties to the Convention acknowledge the constitutional alliances and protocols of the Federation, securing both short-term and long-term benefits of being a Member Sovereign Nation of the Balkan Federation.

The Balkan Federation pledges absolute mutual respect between nations and is committed to bringing prosperity to the children of the Parties to the Convention for generations to come.
